





Annual Report of the Board of Managers

The erection of the new twelve-story lodging house, club house and general headquarters for seamen is, of course, the most striking and important fact connected with the sixty-eighth year of the Society's activities. The Board of Managers is able, however, not only to record this achievement accomplished by its Building Committee, but to report to the friends of the Society that the past year has shown substantial gains in the various departments of the work.

Lodging In spite of our present inadequate facilities, inadequate and Enter-tainment. indeed when compared with what we shall soon be able to offer, over 204,751 visits have been made to our reading and recreation rooms. The number attending our religious services has been 7,038. At the Breakwater, our lodging house in Brooklyn, 29,590 individual lodgings have been furnished. We have checked for safe-keeping 9,148 pieces of dunnage, an increase of 1,333 pieces.

Continuing our customary contribution to the Legal Aid Society we have referred to them 439 cases upon which appropriate action has been taken.

New Building. Work on the New Building has advanced rapidly and at the present time the walls and partitions are completed and the greater part of the plastering has been finished. On April 16th the cornerstone was laid by Mayor Gaynor. Bishop Burch and Bishop Burgess took part in the ceremonies, and addresses were made by Dr. Henry Van Dyke, Bishop Courtney and by Mr. Baylies as Chairman of the Building Committee.

The entire cost of the land and building has not yet been provided and it is greatly desired that the balance needed be secured before the completion of the building, so that it may be opened free of debt. Attention is particularly called to the more detailed report of the Building Committee which follows.

It is expected that the building will be completed and opened ready for work about May 1st, 1913.

Seamen's Savings. Very tangible and practical branches of our work are the Savings Department and our free Shipping Bureau. Gains in these departments mean successful warfare on the sailor's most active foes; on the one hand his own characteristic improvidence,

and on the other the takers of exorbitant and illegal bonuses, the crimps and boarding-house keepers and all the tribes of parasites whose prosperity spell his ruin. During the year \$144,516.85 was entrusted to our care, an increase over last year of \$13,347.85. Of the amount so received by us \$59,601.31 was forwarded to 42 countries, and the balance held for safekeeping. This makes a total of over \$1,000,000 handled by our Institute in the interest of the sailors in the past nine years.

Shipping Bureau. Through our free shipping bureau 2,926 seamen have been shipped by us and we have found shore employment for 1,136, a total of 4,112 with an increase over last year of 653.

Harbor Boat. The "Sentinel," busy in transporting the men whom we have shipped to their outward-bound vessels, and bringing men to our social and religious meetings, continues to be a familiar harbor sight. During the past year the boat has made 385 trips and carried 1,300 men.

Monthly Paper. The "Lookout" has continued to be a successful organ in voicing the needs of the Institute and giving publicity to work for seamen.

Legislation. The Committee on Legislation has recommended the abolition of involuntary servitude for seamen as a penalty for desertion, and a discontinuance of the system of allotment notes to seamen except to dependent relatives. The Board has taken affirmative action in urging Congress to relieve the maritime system from those objectionable features.

The Committee has continued watchful in securing compliance with the life-saving laws heretofore enacted largely through the efforts of this society.

In Memoriam. With sorrow we record the death of Mr. Stuart F. Randolph, since 1901 a member of our Board of Managers. He was a member of the important Ways and Means Committee, and at one time its Chairman. He was diligent in attendance upon the meetings of the Board and of his committees; his counsel was always sought and found helpful, and he will be greatly missed.


Almost at the moment of making this report, we are called on to part with another valued member of our Board of Directors, Mr. James May Duane, whose unexpected death leaves us with a deep sense of bereavement and loss. His devotion to our work was most practical and useful, and his business experience and gentle and courteous nature impressed all who were associated with him.

Finances. We have been compelled to draw about \$9,400 from our trust funds, contributions for the year falling that amount short of our expenses. We have received a legacy of \$1,000 left us by the will of Francis M. Collingwood.

The attention of the Clergy is called to the fact that Canon XVII provides that the Seamen's Church Institute is to be reckoned among the church charities for which provision is to be made.

If all the churches would contribute even in small amounts, the help would be substantial.



The Seamen's Church Institute of New York

whose opportunities for service for seafaring men have been increased many fold by the erection of the new Institute building, aims to aid the seaman in the three following ways:

MATERIALLY—By affording him the chance to live decently in clean lodgings at a price within his means; by enabling him to get a job through the Institute's free shipping bureau; by safeguarding his earnings and encouraging him to forward money home to dependent ones; by giving prompt and sympathetic, though none the less advised, relief in time of sickness or destitution.

SOCIALLY—By affording him recreation through clean games and entertainments; by opportunities to hear lectures on navigation; by protection from the "crimp" and "land-shark"; by the friendship of our workers who act as real brothers and counsellors.

SPIRITUALLY—By the preaching of the Gospel and the celebration of the Communion in our Chapels. Services in the new Chapel will be conducted in the various tongues of the seamen patronizing the Institute.

SECRETARY'S REPORT FOR 1912.

The work of this Society for the year ending December 1st, 1912, has been similar to that of past years. The greater part of its activity has been on behalf of the apprentice boys of the British Merchant Marine.

Six regular meetings were held at the house of Mrs. Wm. B. Shoemaker.

During Lent a sewing class of over one hundred members was organized, which supplied towels and dish-cloths for use in the Institute. There were five meetings of this class held at the residences of Mrs. Arthur Copell, Miss Cornelia Beekman, Mrs. Howard S. Martin, Mrs. John R. Delafield and Miss Margaret Stimson. The class proved a very efficient means of arousing interest in the seamen.

Two Bed Rooms were given to the New Institute in memory of those who lost their lives on the "Titanic."

The usual knitted articles, helmets, mufflers and wrist bands were made and sent to the various branches of the Institute. A number of magazines were also sent to the Battery Station for distribution.




