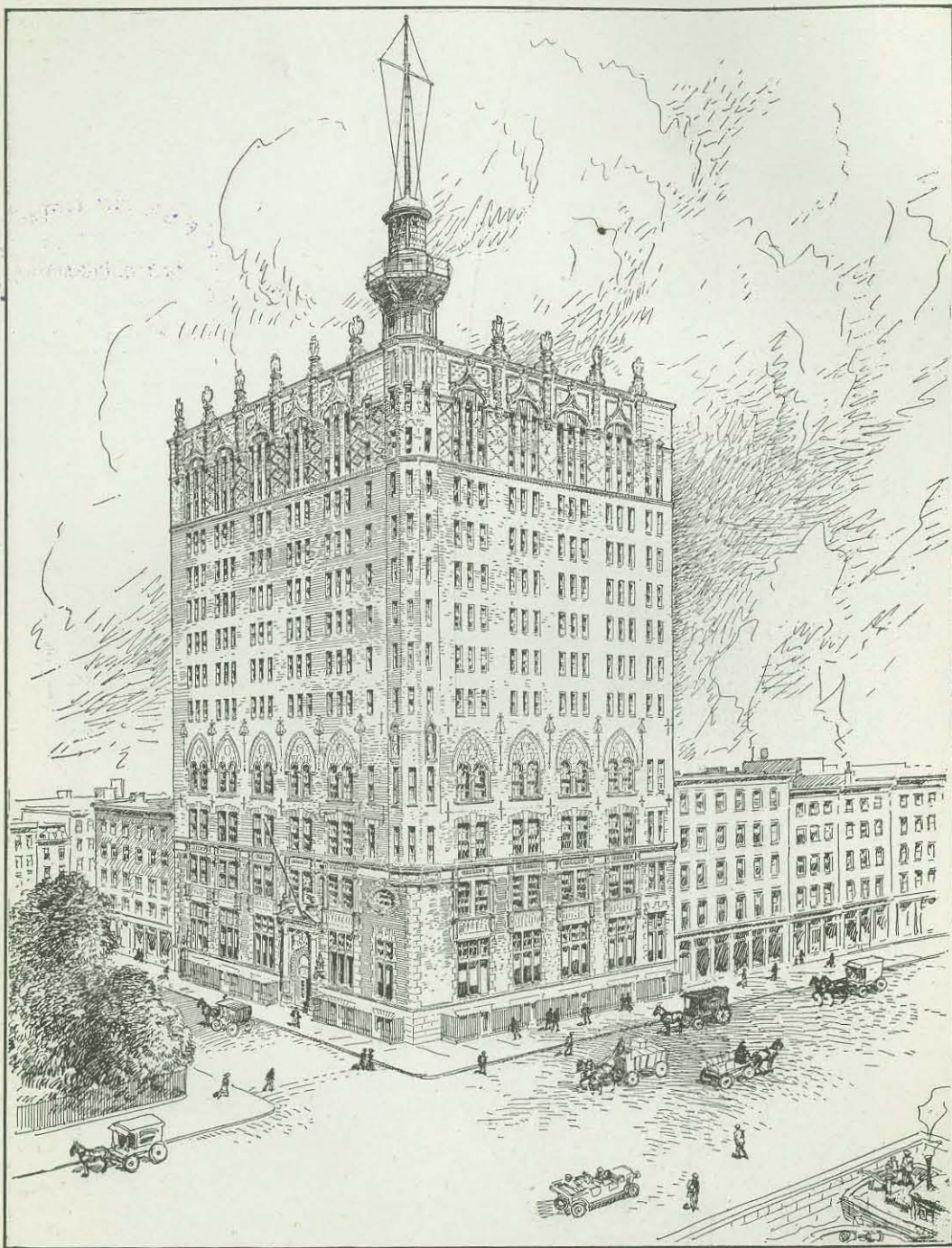

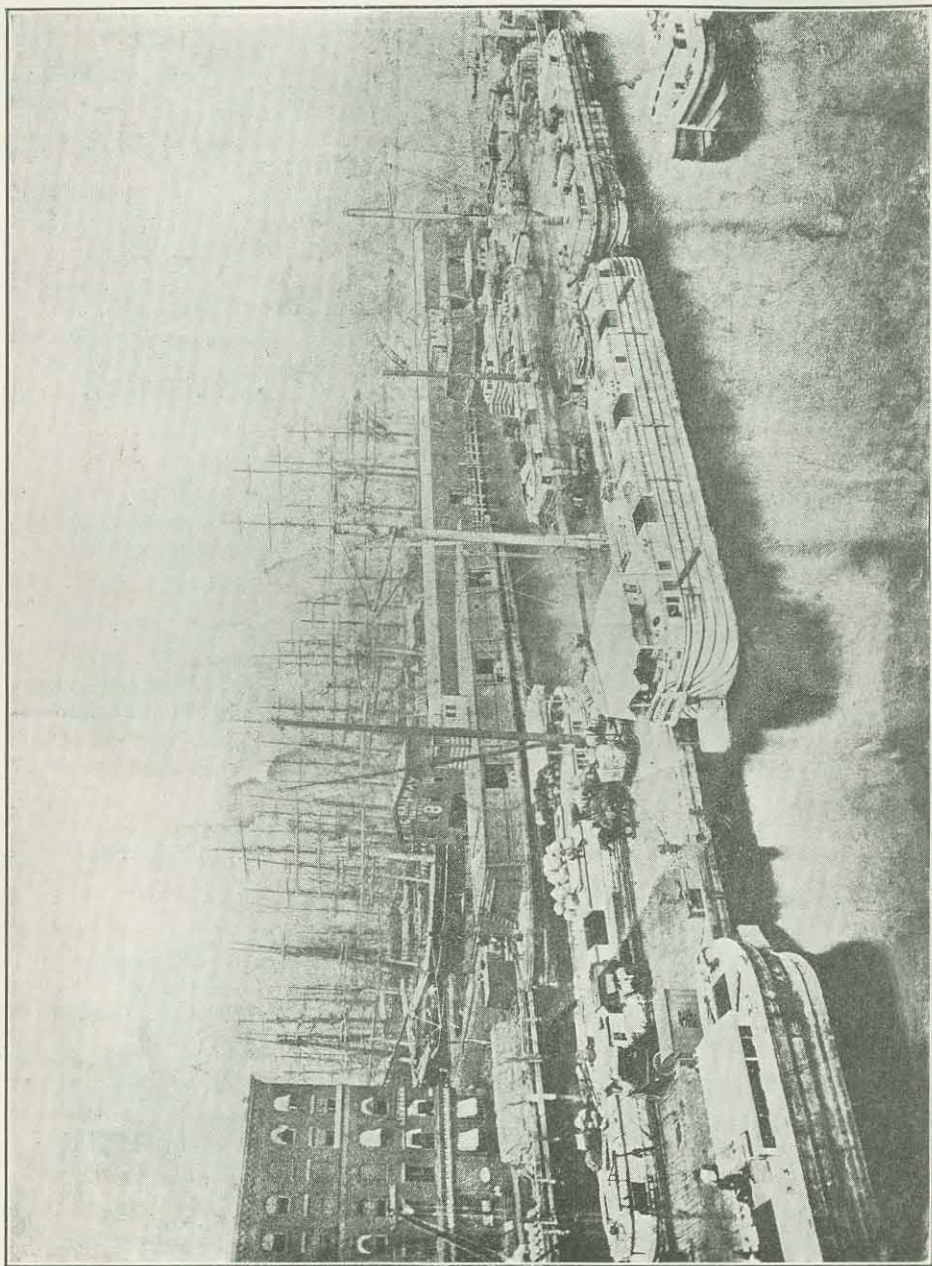

## Annual Report of the Board of Managers

The Sixty-seventh year of the Society's activities has been marked by a development of its usefulness which is most encouraging to the Board of Managers and entitles its friends to feel that their interest has continued to be justified by the results. Not only has the erection of the new twelve story building been actually commenced, but the helpfulness of the service rendered has grown in many directions.

**The Work.** Increasing advantage has been taken of the opportunities offered to make the sailor's shore life less sordid and perilous.

Over 178,000 visits have been made to our reading and recreation rooms, which, at the North River Station especially, have been improved and enlarged. The number attending our religious services has been 7,142. We have given 30 entertainments, with a total attendance of 2,028. The Breakwater, our lodging house in Brooklyn furnishing shelter and meals at moderate cost, has been well patronized, 31,904 individual lodgings having been furnished. We have checked for safekeeping 7,815 pieces of dunnage, an increase of over 1,000 pieces.

We have continued our customary contribution to the Legal Aid Society and have referred to them 249 cases upon which appropriate action has been taken.

**New Building.** During the past year the plans for the new building have been finally perfected, and a considerable amount of additional subscriptions has been received. Under the advice

of its Advisory Committee, consisting of Messrs. Robert S. Brewster, Cleveland H. Dodge, William Douglas Sloane and Francis Lynde Stetson, the Building Committee decided to commence building operations, and work was started on the 1st of September, 1911. It is estimated that it will take from fifteen to eighteen months to complete the structure. The entire cost of the land and building has not yet been provided, and it is greatly desired that the balance needed be secured before the completion of the building so that it may be opened free of debt.

By vote of the Society any one making a contribution of at least \$5,000 to the erection of this Institute will be known as a "Founder," and any one so contributing less than \$5,000, but not less than \$1,000, will be known as "Benefactor."

The interest of many people has been secured by asking them to give toward memorial rooms. The sum of \$100 will build and furnish one of the sailor's bedrooms, of which there will be about 500. These rooms can be named either after the donor or in memoriam. In the same way the



larger rooms in the building, such as the reading and game rooms, can be given by individuals as memorials at a cost of from \$2,000 to \$10,000.

Contributions are being made by the Churches of this Diocese and the Dioceses of Long Island and Newark in sums of \$500 or less. These will be used for the building and furnishing of the Chapel in the new Institute, which, it is estimated, will cost \$15,000. Of this amount about \$10,000 has already been contributed.

Reference is made to the resolutions that were passed unanimously last February by the Chamber of Commerce and by the New York Produce Exchange. The resolutions of the Chamber of Commerce recite in part that

*“Whereas, The Seamen’s Church Institute of New York is engaged in a non-sectarian work of great service in protecting seamen against the inherently bad conditions along the water front, affording them a chance to be decent, to save their money, to become self-reliant, and proposes to erect at the corner of South Street and Coenties Slip a twelve story building . . . . .*

*Resolved, That this Chamber urges ship owners, shippers, transporting interests and all classes of business men interested in the well-being of the Port of New York to support the plan of the Institute for a new building adequate for its comprehensive and beneficent work.”*

**Seamen’s Savings.** The Department in charge of the safekeeping and transmission of sailors’ funds has further proved its value.

Everyone knows of the evil agencies grasping for the wages which are burning holes in the sailors’ pockets; but our appeal to “send your money home” and our ready facilities for turning good resolutions to account, give the family and the future “rainy day” more than a fighting chance. During the past year \$131,169.00 was entrusted to our care, of which \$55,375.49 was forwarded to 38 different countries, and the balance held for safekeeping. This makes a total of \$805,281.93 received by us in the past 7 years.

**Shipping Bureau.** The most practical demonstration of the growth of our work is the substantial increase in the number of men for whom

without charge we have found employment on ships or ashore. This means successful warfare on the sailors’ most active foes—the takers of exorbitant and illegal bonuses, the crimps and boarding house keepers, and all the tribe of parasites whose prosperity means the sailor’s ruin. During the past year 2,224 seamen have been shipped by us, and we have found shore employment for 1,235, a total of 3,459.

**Harbor Boat.** The “Sentinel,” flying the Institute flag, continues to be a familiar harbor sight. Engaged in the friendly business of ferrying the sailors between ship and shore, she has during

the past year made 401 trips and carried 1,513 men. She is busy in transferring, most conveniently, the men whom we have shipped to their outward-bound vessels, and bringing men to our social and religious meetings.

**Monthly Paper.** The publication of the “Lookout” has been continued and has proved a successful organ in voicing the needs of the Institute and in giving publicity to work for seamen in general.

**Legislation.** While no affirmative action has been taken by the Committee on legislation, that Committee is watching the bills now before Congress relative to seamen and the merchant marine and is considering in particular the development of maritime interests in and about the Panama Canal as such development will affect the welfare of seamen.

**In Memoriam.** We record with sorrow the loss by death of two members of our Board of lay managers, Mr. O. Egerton Schmidt and Mr. Tristram Burges Johnson. Mr. Schmidt became a member of the Board in 1890, and for ten years served as Chairman of the Executive Committee. In 1905 he was chosen one of the lay Vice-Presidents, and was one of the first members of the Building Committee. We shall remember him as a steadfast friend of the seamen, a wise counsellor, an indefatigable worker, and a courteous and genial comrade.

Mr. Tristram B. Johnson became a member of the Board in 1905, served on the Battery Station Committee, and for several years was its chairman. He appeared before legislative committees for the purpose of securing legislation beneficial to seamen, and was active in other branches of the work. His labors for the Society were willing, diligent, effective and unassuming. They had just begun, and his loss is most deeply felt.

**Finances.** We have been compelled to draw about \$7,000 from our trust funds, contributions for the year falling that amount short of our expenses. We have been informed that the will of Mr. O. Egerton Schmidt contains a legacy of \$5,000 in our favor, and that Mr. Francis Collingwood has left us by will \$1,000.

The attention of the clergy is called to the fact that Canon XVII provides that the Seamen’s Church Institute is to be reckoned among the church charities for which provision is to be made.

If all the churches would contribute even in small amounts, the help would be substantial.

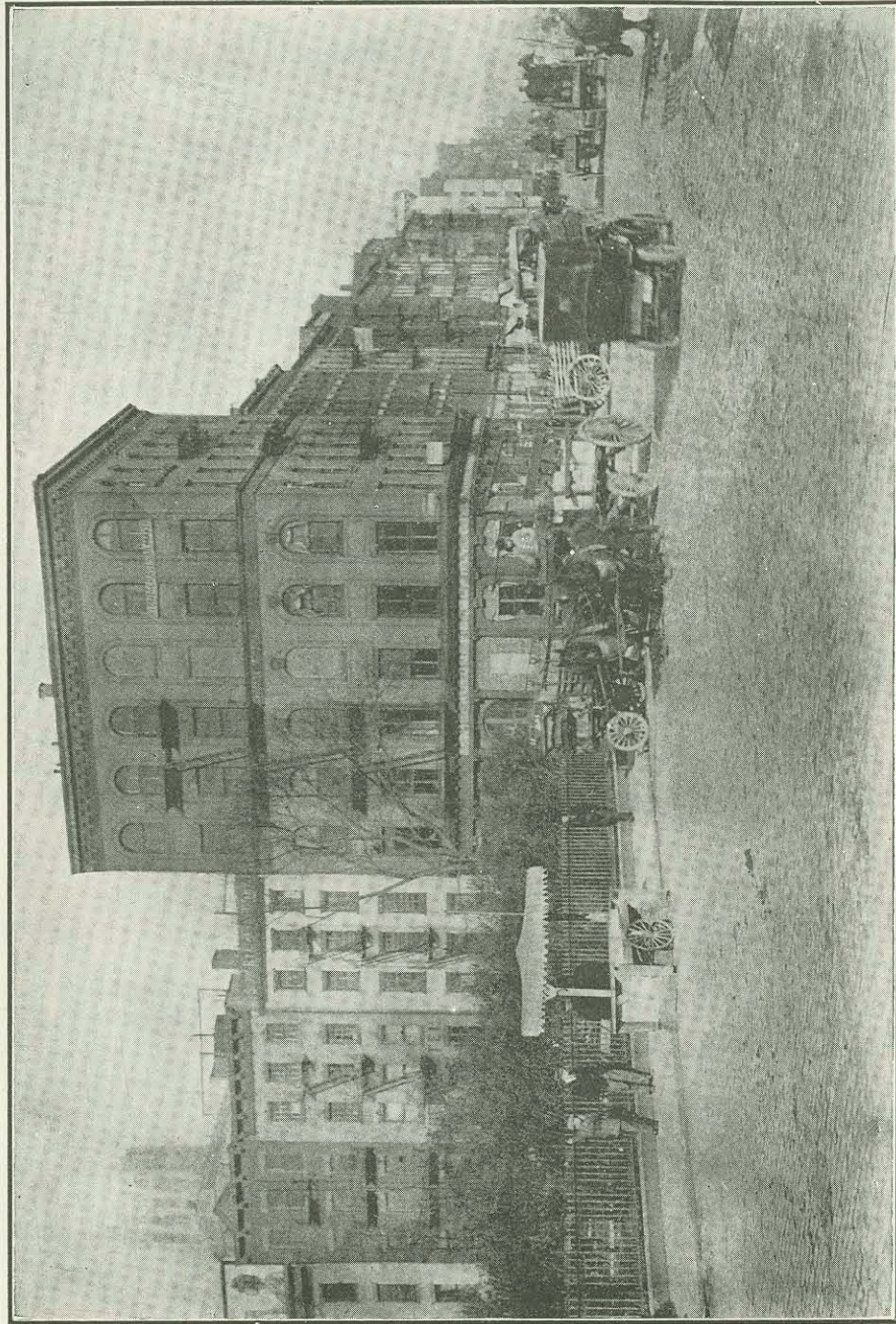

## Building Committee.

NEW YORK, December 6th, 1911.

The Building Committee purposely refrains from making a detailed Report for the past year.

In the Report of the Board of Managers allusion is made to the most important matters that have occurred in relation to the new building during the past year, which may be best summarized as follows:

1. The interest of the New York Chamber of Commerce and the New York Produce Exchange in our project.
2. A large increase in the number of subscriptions for the new building.
3. The actual commencement of building operations on September 1, 1911.

Inasmuch as detailed statements have been printed from time to time in the "Lookout" of all new subscriptions received during the past year, the Committee does not wish to needlessly burden this Report by a repetition of these figures. When the work of the Committee has been completed a full and detailed statement of all receipts and expenditures will be given.

Meanwhile, the Committee desires that all interested in making a success of our new building should use every effort to help the Committee in completing its subscription list. It was originally supposed that the building would cost about \$500,000, but when the estimates, based upon actual plans and specifications, were obtained, it was found that the cost of the building, including architects' fees, etc., fully furnished, would be at least \$675,000. Considerably more than half of this sum has already been raised, and if our friends will continue their efforts during the coming year, the Committee feels that it will be possible to open the new building in the Spring of 1913, fully equipped for work, and free from debt.

## Report of Committee on Legislation, 1911.

The Committee on Legislation has examined the several acts of the Legislature on banking, selling of steamer tickets, deposit of savings and transmission of moneys and has placed copies of same in the hands of the Committee on Battery Station, which has jurisdiction of these matters under the advice of the Society's Counsel.



It has also examined the several bills now pending before the 62d Congress, in behalf of seamen, but it has not yet taken affirmative action in their behalf, as they contain some provisions which do not relate to the protection of sailors.

No new legislation has been initiated by your Committee during the current year. The Seamen's Union is a large and influential body and is affiliated with the Seamen's International Union and with the Federation of Labor, and it is active in promoting its interests in Congress through their own representatives in our National Legislature. So much so, that there remains but little for our Society to do, other than to express our approval of what seems to us to be desirable legislation.

Your Committee has now under consideration House Bill 11372 and Senate Bill 468 respecting the abolition of imprisonment for desertion in foreign ports and the involuntary servitude of seamen for breaking their contracts; the abolition of the allotment note, except for dependent relatives; the prevention of the undermanning and the unskilled manning of American vessels; the training of boys in the American merchant service and of matters pertaining to the periodic payment and control of seamen on shipboard—and for the further protection of life at sea.

At a stated meeting of the Executive Committee of the Seamen's Church Institute of New York, held January 3rd, 1912, the following action was taken:

Mr. J. Augustus Johnson offered the following preamble and resolution, which was seconded by Mr. Baylies:

*Whereas*, The Seamen's Unions of the United States have procured from time to time the introduction of Bills in Congress for their benefit, some of which are now pending, and,

*Whereas*, The Seamen's Church Institute of New York has for 67 years devoted itself to their interests and has promoted the development of the merchant marine at hearings before Congressional Committees, particularly in 1898, and subsequently, be it therefore,

*Resolved*, That after consideration of Bill H. R. 11,372, the Committee on Legislation be and hereby is authorized and instructed to co-operate in all proper ways and to unite with other societies and committees in promoting the enactment of legislation for the better protection of seamen by the amendment of the Act of 1898, to secure among other things,

1. The abolition of the allotment note except to dependent relatives.
2. The abolition of the section permitting a sailor to sign away his right to receive one-half the wages due him at ports of loading or discharge during a voyage.
3. To insure larger fore-castle space for the habitation of seamen and improvement in the food scale.
4. To make each vessel liable for damage, when the master fails to surrender to justice the officer responsible for unlawful violence and cruelty to sailors.
5. To require the inspection of vessels in foreign ports upon demand of a majority of the crew, instead of requiring, as at present, that one of the vessel's officers shall join in such demand.
6. That all vessels shall be adequately supplied, at the port of departure, with boats and with crews able numerically and qualified by experience to handle each vessel and man the boats and to promptly supply all vacancies caused by casualty or desertion, with a full complement of qualified seamen.
7. To require each vessel to carry such number of apprentices as shall be deemed desirable and necessary by the official inspectors charged with the inspection of vessels and crews, with a view to their preparation to become able-bodied seamen.

After full discussion said preamble and resolution were adopted unanimously.

At a stated meeting of the Board of Managers of said Seamen's Church Institute of New York, held February 7th, 1912, the said resolution was approved and the following action was taken:

"Mr. J. Augustus Johnson offered the following resolution; seconded by Mr. Edmund L. Baylies, which was unanimously adopted:

*Resolved*, That this society recommend the abolition of the law providing for the imprisonment of seamen for desertion."

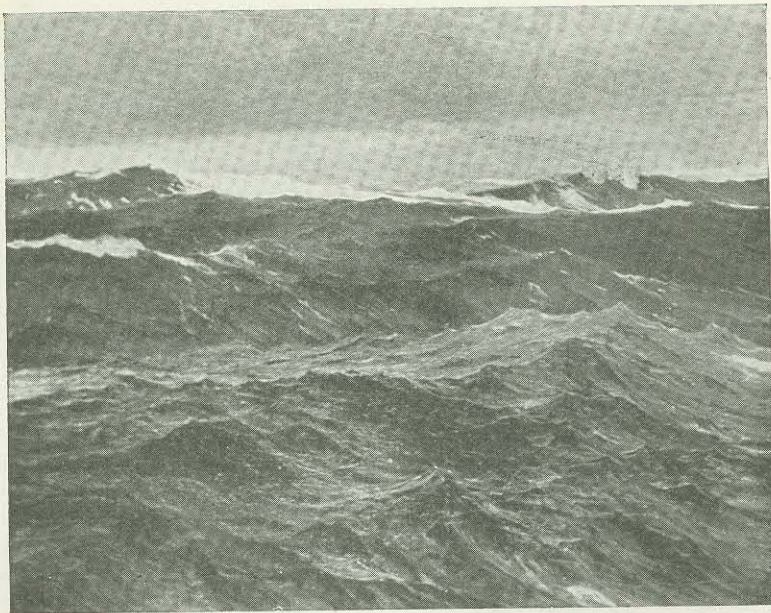

## Annual Report of the Seamen's Benefit Society.

### SECRETARY'S REPORT FOR 1911.

The Seamen's Benefit Society is glad to report good work done during the past year.

Seven business meetings were held at the home of Mrs. Wm. B. Shoemaker, 16 West 55th Street.

On the afternoon of February 16 we ventured on our first attempt at grand opera. The Society leased the Metropolitan Opera House and singers, and gave a performance of *Königskinder*. The public grasped at a good thing. \$5,500 was cleared for the Society. \$2,000 of this was sent to the Treasurer of the Seamen's Church Institute for the maintenance of the mission boat "Sentinel." \$2,000 was voted to pay for the apprentice quarters in the new building.

Nearly two thousand officers and boys visited the temporary headquarters of the Institute during the past year.

Recently a party was given for the "old boys." Many of those attending are now officers on the Trans-Atlantic lines, who came to us as apprentice boys years ago, and are now masters of their own ships.

Miss Margaret D. Leverich has regularly sent donations of flowers for the chapels.

The lectures for "First Aid to the Injured" have been temporarily discontinued but will be resumed in the new Institute. These lectures were given under the direction of the American Red Cross Society.

The Thursday, Saturday and Sunday social teas for officers and boys have been continued at the Battery Station, No. 1 State Street, also the social work at the Breakwater, 19 Atlantic Avenue, Brooklyn. The upkeep of the equipment of both these stations is the principal work of the Society.

Friends of the Society continue to send magazines and knitted articles to the Superintendent.

The Society looks with pleasure on the work done and to be done and the seamen will have friends as long as the Society exists.

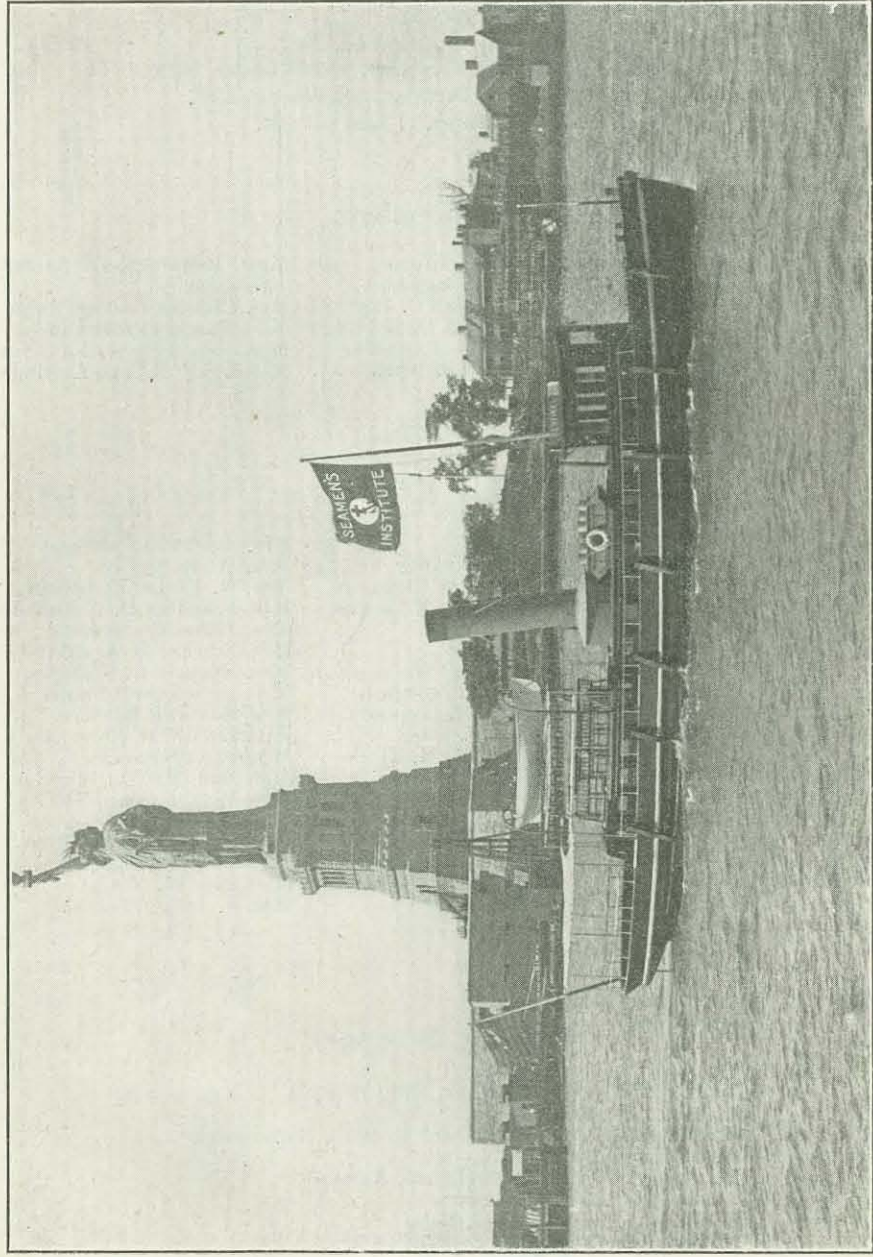
